BPWL LIMITED ("BPWL") MODERN SLAVERY POLICY

1. SCOPE

1.1 This Policy applies to all persons working for or on behalf of BPWL.

2. **PURPOSE**

2.1 To provide an overview of BPWL's commitment to identifying the risks of modern slavery in its operations and supply chain and actions to address such risks.

3. MODERN SLAVERY

- 3.1 Modern slavery captures a wide range of exploitive practices. The most common being human trafficking, forced labour, bonded labour or debt bondage, descent-based slavery, child slavery and forced marriage.
- 3.2 The Australian Modern Slavery Act 2018 (Cth) provides further guidance on the definition of modern slavery.
- 3.3 BPWL recognizes that modern slavery has devastating social impacts on communities globally.

4. POLICY

- 4.1 BPWL is committed to addressing potential and actual risks of modern slavery that may or could exist in our operations and supply chain.
- 4.2 We demonstrate this commitment by:
 - (a) providing training to our employees to raise awareness and to help them identify potential risks of modern slavery in BPWL's operations and supply chains;
 - (b) reviewing our supply chain to ensure that we do not indirectly contribute to modern slavery;
 - (c) providing our employees with a non-discriminative work environment and encouraging them to speak up about any modern slavery risks they become aware of;
 - (d) prohibiting engagement in any form of modern slavery in our supply chains;
 - (e) continually engaging with our suppliers to better understand their supply chains and any potential modern slavery risks they face; and
 - (f) where modern slavery issues are identified, taking appropriate action.

5. REPORTING DISCLOSURE AND REMEDIATION

- 5.1 BPWL takes any allegations of modern slavery or human rights breaches seriously.
- 5.2 BPWL expects and encourages its employees to report any concerns regarding unethical conduct, or any actual or suspected occurrence of modern slavery.
- 5.3 If BPWL identifies that it has caused, contributed or is directly or indirectly linked to any form of actual or suspected modern slavery, we will take steps to address, co-operate or remediate the issue as soon as possible.
